Planting guide



1 Prepare the site

If planting in a lawn, dig an area at least twice the diameter of the pot.



2 Prepare the soil

Make sure the soil in the pot is moist. If the soil is dry, fill the hole with water and allow to drain before planting.



3 Planting

Carefully ease the plant from its pot and loosen the root ball. Place the plant in the hole.



4 Replacing soil

Break up any hard clods when replacing the soil around the plant. Using excess soil, form a well around the plant to collect water.



5 Watering

Immediately after planting, water the plant generously using a bucket or watering can. Please ensure you adhere to water restrictions by using recycled or tank water. During the first two to three weeks after planting, soak the plant every few days. Remember, if it rains, there is no need to water.

*Trees are for planting on private property only.

Conditions

- All ratepayers are entitled to two free trees per year by presenting their January rates notice.
- Maximum of five rates notices per common property.
- Body corporate/unit complex managers should submit their request in writing, and include details of five ratepayers from their complex.
- Trees to be planted on private property only.
- Watering and maintenance is to be provided by ratepayers, in accordance with water restriction requirements.

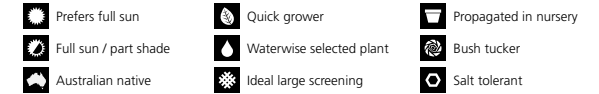
Use this information guide to select the plants most suitable for your garden. You can help green and shade the Gold Coast for years to come. Trees are given away from January – May.
